





Relational Trauma Repair 14 HR Training

A live, in-person training, including didactic instruction and experiential, applied learning.

Training Description

Tian Dayton, PhD, TEP, developed her sociometric processes to fit easily into all modalities of treatment — residential and outpatient programs, clinics, and one-to-one settings. Sociometrics can be used as discreet processes that enhance any program that wishes to integrate experiential, psychoeducational, and embodied processes into their programming. During this training, participants will receive instruction and guidance on how to facilitate Dayton's core sociometric processes: floor checks, the trauma timeline, the resilience timeline, and experiential letter writing. In addition, participants will get the same guidance and instruction on JL Moreno's spectrogram and locogram as well as beginning exposure to the basic psychodrama techniques of doubling and role-reversal.

Learning Objectives:

- 1. Participants will be able to understand and explain the steps of the sociometric processes floor checks, resilience and trauma timelines, experiential letter writing, locograms and spectrograms.
- 2. Participants will be able to practice the sociometric processes floor checks, resilience and trauma timelines, experiential letter writing, locograms and spectrograms.
- 3. Participants will be able to answer common questions regarding the facilitation of the sociometric processes.
